## Healing of the Official's Son

1. (4:43) From the earlier passage, where was Jesus when he left for Galilee (cf. v 40)?
2. (4:44) To what "country" was Jesus likely referring when he said a prophet has no honor in his own country (cf. 4:24-29)? Why? What significance might the statement have beyond the obvious?
3. (4:45) What changed the Galilean's attitude toward Jesus? Why do you suspect they welcomed Jesus? How does 2:23 help us understand 4:45?
4. (4:46-47) What town did Jesus visit in Galilee and in what town was the official's sick son? Locate the two towns on a map. From verses 51-52, what distance (in time) likely separates the two towns? Based on these verses, speculate on the extent of Jesus' fame. What evidences do the verses suggest as to the emotional state of the royal official?
5. (4:48) Compare 4:48 with 4:39 and 2:23-25. What is apparently the depth of the "belief" that people had in Jesus? The official asks for help and Jesus speaks of "signs" and belief. What is Jesus' likely meaning?
6. (4:49) With what attitude does the official respond to Jesus? Is the official's response faith, desperation or something else?
7. (4:50) Based on the rest of the story, speculate on why Jesus chose not to go with the man. Based on Jesus' response, the official now faces a dilemma – describe it. Compared to verse 49, how would you now describe the official's belief? What evidence did the official have that his son would live?
8. (4:51) Speculate on why the servants met the official. Because the official went to get Jesus, who would the servants have expected to meet on the road?
9. (4:52) What question is implied by the official's question regarding the timing of his son's healing? Do you think the official expected a miracle or a coincidence? Why?
10. (4:53) On what basis would the official's family (and servants) think the boy's recovery was anything other than a normal recovery? The official's faith apparently grows in the story. Describe the official's belief in v46. How had it developed by v49, by v50 and by v53?
