How accurate is the man's description of what Jesus told him to do?

Do you think the man was a Christian by the time he could see? Why or why not?

3. (v. 9:13-16) Who brought the formerly blind man to the Pharisees?

What about the incident divided the Pharisees?

Which side of the 9:16 controversy does the formerly blind man take?

What did the parents confirm and what would they not confirm? Why?

4. (v. 9:24-34) What is the testimony of the formerly blind man?

What two comments by the formerly blind man infuriate the Pharisees? Why?
